Morning Circle Time (25–30 Minutes)

This is the most important part of the day because it builds confidence, communication, values, and happiness.

1. Welcome Circle (3 Minutes)

Teacher and children sit in a circle.

Teacher says:

Good Morning, Super Stars!

How are you today?

Are you happy, excited or sleepy?

Children reply together.

2. Emotion Check (2 Minutes)

Ask:

How are you feeling today?

Why are you happy?

Did anything make you sad?

Children can point to Happy, Sad, Excited, Angry, or Sleepy emotion cards.

3. Daily Conversation (5 Minutes)

Discuss:

What day is today?

What is today's date?

What month is this?

What season is it?

How is the weather today?

What colour is the sky?

What clothes should we wear today?

4. Sharing Time (5 Minutes)

Every day, 3–4 children speak.

Topics:

What did you eat today?

Who brought you to school?

What did you do yesterday?

Which cartoon do you like?

Tell us one funny thing.

What makes you smile?

Show something inside your bag.

Teacher appreciates every child.

5. Fun Activity (5 Minutes)

Choose one activity daily:

Action Song

Simon Says

Pass the Smile

Clap Pattern Game

Animal Walk

Freeze Dance

Guess the Sound
Mirror Game
Balloon Passing
Magic Box Guessing Game

6. Value of the Day (3 Minutes)

One value daily. Examples:

Be Kind

Respect Parents
Keep Classroom Clean
Share Toys
Say Please
Say Thank You

Teacher gives one real-life example.

7. Show & Tell (3 Minutes)

Children speak for 30–60 seconds.

8. Thought of the Day (2 Minutes)

Examples:
I Can Do It.
I Am Kind.

9. Appreciation Time (1 Minute)

Teacher says:
Let's clap for everyone.
Thank you for speaking confidently.
Today everyone is a Star.
Give Star, Smile or High-Five.

Rules for the Mother Teacher

End the session with a positive affirmation and a group cheer.
